# REFERRAL OF A PROPOSAL TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AUTHORITY UNDER SECTION 38(5) OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT 1986

The Department of Environment Regulation (DER) has recently received an application from the Department of Water to clear 0.09 hectares of native vegetation within Lot 5607 on Deposited Plan 208673, Pinjar, for the purpose of drilling groundwater monitoring bores.

The proposed clearing is within an area subject to the Environmental Protection (Gnangara Mound Crown Land) Policy 1992, which places restrictions on clearing native vegetation within the policy area unless authorised under the Act to do so.


No authorisation exists for clearing in accordance with section 51C of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act). Accordingly, I have formally referred this application to the Environmental Protection Authority for consideration and determination.


A preliminary assessment of the principles outlined in Schedule 5 of the EP Act has been undertaken and is attached for your information.



CPS 5837/1 - Context Map (AM25)






2.1.1. Description of the native vegetation under application

**Vegetation Description** 

The areas under application have been mapped as Beard Vegetation Condition Vegetation Association 1014 which is described as low woodland: banksia / shrublands; teatree thicket (AM10 Duffy Road, Yeal); and Beard Vegetation Association 949 which is described as low woodland; banksia (AM25 -Neaves Road, Pinjar) (Shepherd et al, 2001)

Degraded: Structure severely disturbed; regeneration to good condition requires intensive management (Keighery 1994)

Consideration has been given to impacts to biodiversity, significant fauna habitat, rare flora, threatened ecological communities, remnant vegetation values, wetlands, watercourses, land degradation, surface water quality, groundwater quality, and flooding. 


